



### **Acworth Police Community Foundation Scholarship Criteria**

1. The recipient must be a high school student either at a high school located within the City limits of Acworth or a high school student living within the City limits of Acworth.
2. The recipient must be enrolled in an accredited high school program, either full-time or part-time.
3. The recipient must be a high school senior.
4. The scholarship funds will be paid to the scholarship recipient.
5. The scholarship fund will provide \$1,000 for each scholarship winner's educational expenses.
6. The scholarship may be used at any two-year or four-year accredited college or university or at a technical trade school.
7. A combination of academic ability, character qualities, and community involvement will be used on a weighted scale in determining scholarship fund winners.
8. The Acworth Police Community Foundation's Board will oversee and administer the scholarship funding.
9. Scholarship winners must notify the Acworth Police Community Foundation Coordinator of their acceptance of the award and the name of the school they will attend by June 1st, or they will forfeit the scholarship.
10. Scholarship finalists may be invited to attend a formal interview process.
11. Scholarship applicants will receive an email notice or phone call that their application was received.
12. A scholarship committee will select the winners by the end of May.
13. The 2026 scholarship winners will be announced on the Acworth Police Community Foundation website.
14. Acworth Police Community Foundation and Acworth Police Department members and their children are not eligible for this scholarship.
15. Applications must be postmarked no later than May 4, 2026.
